

Pin Point Tennis Team Child Protection Policy

The aim of this policy is to ensure that everyone is treated fairly and with respect of members, non members and visiting place to plays and teams are not denied access to Pin Point Tennis Team's Places to Play because of a discriminatory reason.

This policy is fully supported by Pin Point Tennis Team who is responsible for the implantation and review of this policy.

Pin Point Tennis Team will therefore adhere to the following:

- a. Aims to create an enjoyable environment for all juniors who wish to take part in tennis or other sports and social activities.
- b. Believe that children and young people have the right to be safe, secure and free from threat.
- c. Believe that young people have the right to be treated with respect and to have their concerns listened to acted upon.
- d. Ensure that the needs of the junior members are provided for through specific programmes, designated facilities and safe practice.
- e. Have procedures in place to address poor practice and to help any person who appears to be at risk or who appears to be the victim of abuse.
- f. Offer help and support when a child or young person tells us that these issues affect them.
- g. Take steps to ensure that any volunteers or professionals working with children are suitable to do so, through the use of references and background checks.
- h. Ensure that all relevant people have been vetted and approved through the LTA's Criminal Record bureau disclosure process.
- i. Ensure that all of those working with children are made aware of the LTA Code of Conduct for people working with children in tennis and are required to follow it.
